The next project to be undertaken is to make simple, lightweight clothes for the children at two schools in Kenya, to be delivered in January 2020 by an Albury church member. The straight forward pattern can be accomplished by anyone with a

basic sewing knowledge. Help is needed in cutting out the patterns, sewing the fabric, threading elastic or cord in the garments and labelling and packing the garments.

Survivor kits contain: Shampoo, conditioner, body wash, soap, toothbrush, toothpaste body lotion/moisturiser, small pack of tissues, face washer, comb, hair ties and clips, bandaids, chapstick, deodorant, hand sanitiser, sealable plastic bags, torch, small notebook and pen, Impulse spray, mini sewing kit, chux, emery board, feminine hygiene, antiseptic cream, tweezers, tubes of sunscreen, food items, nail clippers and a small mirror
